# **STUDY**

## **TEACHING**

Began teaching in 1979. Teaches all levels of bonsai, and has been an instructor at the Chicago Botanic Garden, Morton Arboretum, Field Museum, Buddhist Temple of Chicago, Yasukunai Bonsai Garden & School, and several garden centers in the Chicagoland area. Sensei to Grand Rapids, Michigan, study group from 2006 to date, as well as Yasuragi Bonsai Society, Grand Rapids, Michigan, from 2007 to date.
